**Youth Building:** Taping is being done now, then water and electrical can be done, waiting for septic est.

**Van Ministry:** Has ran every Sunday for almost 2 months, going slow but will continue to run.

**Work Team:** Accomplished a lot, could not do pavilion (permits).

**Other Work teams coming later:** Apr. 25 - May 3, 2013- 10-12 people men and women to do light construction and ?? Team of 16-18 nursing students to do back yard Bible clubs, CPR classes, and more, May 20-30, 2013.

**Status on Land:** The surveyor is working on the subdividing, it will be submitted when he is done and then the 5 and 10 year plans can be submitted.

**2 Adult SS class were added?** Our SS attendance has increased and some new ones are coming.

**Keikiland is doing very well:** 40-45 enrolled by the end of the week.

**Website:** Hits have increased (almost 1250 per mo.) Facebook increasing, sermons on iTunes.

**World Changers:** We will be going to World Changers on Oahu, July 21-27, 2013. Debbie and I will be leading, organizing and recruiting for it. We will also need to go to training in mid Jan. 2013.

**New Sanctuary:** Have plans on table for review (these are just initial plans).

**Sign:** Keikiland deposited \$3,000.00 into designated fund for sign (we will need to deposit \$3,000.00 later).

**Debbie and I will be gone:** Jan. 14 - Feb. 2, 2013. We will be at WC training and then visiting family.

**Prayer Conference:** Held by Chris and Tamee Schofield from NC on Feb. 17-19, 2013 (Sun., Mon., Tues.).

**New Bible Studies:** In Jan. 2013 a new class on Monday for Financial Peace University, Wed. on End Time Prophecy with David Whitehead and a new Thursday men's study will be started.

**Challenge to the Church:** To pray for the leadership, spirit of the church, lost to be reached, saved to be disciplined, growth, finances, and building finances (new buildings to accomplish His work) as a minimum.

**Make nursery priority:** Refurnish the nursery area completely.

**Childcare needs met:** We need to find ways to take care of the children of parents who want to come to Bible Studies or other events of the church.

**More Community events:** We need to become part of more things in the community; parades, back to school bash, Mops, etc. and conduct more events open to the community (two ladies events scheduled).

**Make an Operations Manual for the Church:** That covers everything the church does and how it's done.

**We may need to evaluate going to two services or use a tent:** This will take a great coordinating effort.

### **A list of a few things accomplished from Oct. 1, 2011 - Sep. 30, 2012**

We have added 2 youth and 2 adult SS classes along with our entire children's dept. being revamped (over 40 workers scheduled through), 6 weekly Bible studies added/started with attendance between 70 and 80 per week, grown in SS attendance, doubled in Worship Attendance (last 6 months avg. 158), baptized 12, started a program where 6-8 adults meet together 1 or 2 times a month (over 50 involved) and every 3 months are reassigned, have given the church a computer based Spiritual Gift inventory (also part of new comers class), started a food pantry (giving out food to 2 or 3 families weekly and have had as many as 7), started a van ministry (has been slow start) running every Sunday morning, started using rightnowmedia.com as a valuable resource, created an Organizational Chart hand out, have a talk story time with congregation about every two months to talk about where we have been and where God is leading.

**Building and property wise:** Have added over 100 loads of fill dirt dumped for free and will have a couple hundred more to come, added additional parking for approx. 40-50 cars, surveyed church properties, hired an architect and are working on new building drawings, extended the sanctuary area to seat an additional 50 people, enlarged the nursery, built a sound area that opens to the center of the main worship area, built a shed for storage approx 11' X 32', rebuilt what was a covered sandbox (raised the roof, put in door, windows and walls) and now is a SS classroom, continue working on youth building: sheet rocked and now taping (will finish and use by the end of 2012), bought over 100 new chairs several tables and gave Ocean View Mission over 90 of the old chairs, bought several flat screen TV's and DVD players (now have one in every room). Since Oct 1, 2012 we have Baptized 3, and averaged 162 in worship.

### **Results of Survey Taken on Oct 7, 12 Comparing 2012 to prior year (answers YES, NO, SAME, NA)**

1. Have you grown in Christ? 92% yes
2. Have members of your family grown in Christ? 86% yes
3. Have you become more active? 80% yes, 17% same
4. Has your love for the church (God's People) grown? 92% yes
5. Are there more Bible Studies available to you? 83% yes
6. Are you attending more Bible Studies than before? 54% yes, 24% same
7. Have you made a decision (i.e. salvation, baptism, rededication, membership?) 46% yes
8. Do you pray more now? 76% yes, 24% same
9. Is the church as a whole more active now? 97% yes
10. Is the church fellowship better now? 95% yes
11. Do you feel the Holy Spirit is allowed to move in the services more now? 93% yes
12. Have you grown closer to more people in the church than before? 90% yes
13. Do visitors feel more welcomed now? 86% yes
14. Do attendees feel more welcomed now? 83% yes
15. Voting on Pastor Denver and Debbie today? 100% yes one NA
